

Important news please read

You have received this letter because we have just installed a **community safety alarm** to your neighbours property.

The community safety alarm is not a burglar alarm . It will not give false alarms or unduly disturb your peace.

The alarm is operated by either a hand operated panic button or by a linked smoke detector.

The panic button will be **ONLY** be used to sound the external alarm in cases of the occupant being distressed. They can operate the alarm via installed panic buttons or carried panic buttons on wrist or neck.

If you hear this alarm your neighbour may -

- Have been taken ill or fallen
- Be under threat from intruders
- Be under pressure from callers
- Be summoning help for a partner
- Need reassurance or assistance from a neighbour

If you hear the alarm we would ask you politely to simply check that your neighbour is safe or that someone else has gone to check the problem.

If the alarm is sounding in *bursts of three followed by gaps* then the siren has been set off by a **linked smoke detector**
In this case the house may be unoccupied or occupied as the alarm is automatic on detection of smoke.

If you see smoke within the home upon checking please call the fire brigade immediately.

When the alarm is activated the siren will also display red flashing led lights in the blue panel.
